### **New Drive-Through COVID-19 Testing Site to Open in Montgomery County**

On Thursday, April 16, 2020 at 10:00 a.m., a new drive-through testing location opened on the Central Campus of the Montgomery County Community College in Whippain Township. This site will provide self-swab COVID-19 testing, by appointment only. The site will remain open from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. daily (Monday – Saturday), as testing supplies allow. Registration for each day’s appointments will open at 8 AM each morning and will remain open until all available spots are filled.
